TIMPANI STICK CASE AND CADDIES

Timpani Stick Case

My timpani stick case is light in weight but is well made of black vinyl-covered wood with brass-plated metal edge protectors, black plastic edge protectors, and a sturdy carrying handle. The lockable stick case (padlock not included) measures 18 inches long, 12 inches wide, and is a roomy 6.5 inches deep. The interior bottom half of the case is completely lined with black felt, and a snap-equipped restraint strap holds the caddie-mounted sticks in place. The upper half of the case has plenty of room to carry music and has two snap-straps to hold the music in place during transport. The case provides excellent protection for your timpani sticks and can be ordered either with or without the caddies, although the caddies are highly recommended.

Timpani Stick Caddies

The Carlisle Percussion Products timpani stick caddies measure 10 inches by 13 inches and are my own invention. They are lightweight and are padded with black felt. Timpani sticks are placed under an elastic band sewn to each caddie. The caddies keep your sticks flat in the case during transport. The stick heads extend over the opposite ends of the caddie so that when the two caddies are mounted one on top of the other in the case, the felt-covered heads of the sticks do not press against each other. This helps to keep your sticks in top shape and extends their life.

I'll let you know the charges for shipping to your address by return email. It is also possible to ship new timpani sticks that you order in your new stick case. Usually, the price of shipping the sticks in the case is very competitive with the cost to ship the case alone, so if you are thinking about buying both sticks and a case, it is better to order both at one time. Stick cases can also be mailed internationally. If you elect to have the order insured, an additional post office charge will apply depending on the order total. If you do not insure the order, I cannot be responsible for any damages that occur once the order has left my hands. Foreign orders must be shipped insured. Please email me for details.
